Entries will be released starting at 4:30 pm, Saturday, June 20. **Please attach a copy of this entry form to your item.**

Complex Weavers Award

Criteria:

This Award is to be given for excellence in weaving that meets the following criteria:

- The winning piece should be original in both design and execution with a complex interlacement of threads and fibers beyond plain weave.
- There is no requirement that the piece must be woven on a designated number of shafts or on a multi-shaft loom.

With the following limitations:

- Pieces taken directly from published works are not eligible for the Award.
- Kits are not eligible for the Award.
- Workshop samples or pieces woven under supervision are not eligible for the Award.

Award Recipient:

The Complex Weavers Award includes:

- Certificate
- Handwoven ribbon
- One year membership (new or renewal) in Complex Weavers.

The winner will need to complete three forms: Winners Information, Membership Form and Permission Form.

In return, CW asks for a description of the piece and a high resolution jpeg, slide and/or photograph that may be used in the Complex Weavers Journal and any future compilations or composite CW publications, on the website, and archived by CW. It may also be the case that we would ask for an additional short article for the CW Journal. None of these are requirements for the Award, however.
