## **RULES**

- You must have completed your entry after the last MAWS Conference, June 26th, 2022.
- Fashion Show entries must be submitted by July 15th 2024.
- You may enter multiple garments in the fashion show. Please fill out an additional entry form for each garment/accessory. Just your name and garment information is needed on the additional fashion show forms.
- Items may be entered in both the Fashion Show and the Open Show. Separate forms will need to be completed for each show and item.
- Please provide a photo of your garment/accessory to be included in the printed program and shown on the TV screen during the fashion show.
  The photo can be of you or the person you made the item for modeling your entry. If the entry is photographed using a mannequin or on a hanger please include an additional photo of yourself. Bring a copy of your Fashion Show entry form to the conference and turn it in when you register at the conference.
- Submit your Fashion Show entry form and photos via email to <a href="joyful54@gmail.com">joyful54@gmail.com</a> or print and mail the completed form to Joy Erickson, 9010 King Avenue West, Billings, MT 59106.
- There will be a People's Choice Award for the Fashion Show.
- Bring your Fashion Show garment/accessory items to the fashion show staging area at 8:30 am, Sunday, August 4th.
- If your items were entered in the Open Show you will need to pick them up from the Open Show Sunday morning and bring them to the Fashion Show staging area.
- All Open Show entries must be delivered to the open show area absolutely no later than August 1, 2024, 7:30pm.
- Mailed entry forms will be acknowledged via the email address you provide. If you do not receive a confirmation email within 10 days of mailing your entry form please contact Joy to verify receipt of your entry.
